KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, Mary Taylor and W.P. Taylor of Greer,  
 Greenville County, in the State aforesaid  
 in consideration of the sum of Three hundred seventy-two Dollars,  
 to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

J.P. Taylor and E.W. Moon (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J.P. Taylor and E.W. Moon, All that tract or lot of land designated as Lot number 9, surveyed by A.R. Wood Jan. 1910, joining lands of E.C. Bailey, D.D. Davenport and lots number 4 and 8 being a part of the land conveyed to Mary Taylor by her Mother Mrs. Nancy Hawkins by her deed April 8, 1880. See Book A, page 171, Vol. K.K. page 415, containing two, 2.48 acres, more or less, having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning on a stone (OM) on E.C. Baileys corner and running South 39-3/4 E. along E.C. Baileys land to a stone (NM) at corner of lot number 8, 8.43 chains; thence North 75-3/4 West to a stone (NM) on line of lot number 8, 2.04 chains; thence North 25 East to a stone on D.D. Davenports land 7.15 chains; thence to beginning 4.35 chains, degree unknown.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said J.P. Taylor and E.W. Moon, their heirs and assigns, forever.

AND we do hereby bind ourselves and our heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said J.P. Taylor and E.W. Moon, their

heirs and assigns, against us and our heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
