

Noah Cannon Deed TO James A. Cannon

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Noah Cannon, of the Town of Greer, in the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of the natural love and affection and Five Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

James A. Cannon (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said James A. Cannon, that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in Chick Springs Township, in Greenville County in the State aforesaid, bounded by lands of T.B. Snow and lands of Colored Church fronting on Mostellar Road, James Street and Pelham Road, and containing ten acres, more or less.

Also one other certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the Town of Greer on the East side of the Mostellar Road and on North side of Maud Street and bounded on North and East by lands of J. Terry Wood and contains three fourth of an acre, more or less.

It is a part of the consideration of this deed that the said Jas. A. Cannon is to pay an annual sum of one hundred dollars to Noah Cannon or to Eugenia A. Cannon during their natural life for their support.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Jas. A. Cannon, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, & my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said James A. Cannon, his

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
