for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred and Fifty Dollars,
to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. H. and Phebie Sullivan,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. H. and Phebie Sullivan, All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being near the Town of Simpsonville, Greenville County, and State aforesaid on the East side of the Stage Road and contains Seven acres, more or less, and hath the following metes and bounds to wit: Bounded by old Stage Road W. A. Thomason and others commencing on a stone in Stage Road J. H. and Phebie Sullivans corner running thence up said N. 10 3/4 E. 6.31 to an angle; thence N. 1/2 W. 1.30 to Ben Thomason's corner thence N. 55 1/2 E. 2.69 to a stone; thence N. 28 1/2 E. 3.04 to N. 57 E. 1.30 to a stone; thence S. 14 1/2 E. 10.81 to a stone; thence S. 75 1/2 W. 9.45 to beginning.
