Bramlett, Elizabeth Bramlett (Deed.) and in the further consideration of the sum of Five in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of an equal partition and division of the Estate of Dollars to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

Louis E. Bramlett (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Louis E. Bramlett, all that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid on Wiers Creek, waters of North Saluda River, and in Saluda Township and has the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a stone on Hattie Speegles line; thence N. 5 E. 18.25 ch. to a stone in branch; thence down said branch N. 25- $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 4.40 ch. to a Box Elder on right bank of Wiers Creek; thence N. 8- $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 32.00 ch. to a stone; thence S. 80- $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 17.06 ch. to a stone; thence S. 2 E. 13.60 ch. to a stone (formerly a poplar); thence down a branch as a line 17.20 ch. to Wiers Creek; thence down said Creek about 5.00 ch. to a stone on the left bank of Creek; thence S. 21 E. 8.00 ch. to a stone; thence S. 22 E. 4.50 ch. to a sourwood; thence S. 59- $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 9.20 ch. to a stone; thence S. 84 E. 5.00 ch. to a stone; thence S. 58 E. 3.10 ch. to the beginning corner, containing eighty-two (82) acres, more or less, adjoining lands of Hattie Speegle and others.
