KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J.L. Woodside, recorded in office of Judge of Probate for Greenville, Co., in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of Ten thousand, nine hundred and fifteen Dollars to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

John T. Woodside (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

John T. Woodside all that certain tract of land situate in Oak-Lawn Township, County and State aforesaid, known as the Old Woodside Plantation, containing two hundred and twenty-one and three-fifths (221-3/5) acres, more or less, being lots Nos. 1-2-3-4-5 and 6 as shown by plat of survey of the lands of which J.L. Woodside died, seized and possessed, made by James Adams Surveyor on the 16th, day of September 1909.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said

John T. Woodside, his heirs and assigns forever.

AND we do hereby bind ourselves as of J.L. Woodside executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said John T. Woodside, his

heirs and assigns, against ourselves as Executors and the heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
