

J.H. Glenn DEED TO H.R. McFee

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J.H. Glenn of State and County aforesaid in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of Six hundred (\$600.00) Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

H.R. McFee of State and County aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

H.R. McFee, his heirs and assigns all that tract, parcel and piece of land, situated and lying and being in Greenville County, State of S.C., containing fifty-six and one-half acres (56-1/2) more or less, same being tract of land conveyed to J.H. Glenn by Mary C. - Childress, Deed of same being recorded in Book I.I.I. page 499, R.M.C. Greenville County S.C. 20th, day January 1902.. Said tract being bounded on branch waters of Mush Creek, on North by W.Y. Batson, J.T. Gilreath on the East and on the West by lands of W.Y. Batson & others.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said H.R. McFee, -- heirs and assigns forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said H.R. McFee and his

heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
