J.J. McSwain (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J.J. McSwain, All my undivided interest in both real and personal Estate of Gabriel Thompson deceased of whom my Mother, Caroline Hunt was a lawful child & of whom I am a lawful grandchild, said Carolina Hunt, Hunt having only three Children, and my Father Earle Hunt is dead, said Estate consists of personal property, money, notes, etc. the real Estate consists of about three hundred & fifty acres more or less, being all land of which Gabriel Thompson died seized and possessed, all in said County & State.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said J.J. McSwain, his heirs and assigns forever.

AND I do hereby bind my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said J.J. McSwain, his

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
