(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Rufus Dandy, all that piece, parcel or tract of land situate in Gantt Township, County and State aforesaid and about seven miles South of Greenville Court-house, and having the following metes and bounds:
