 sell and release, unto the said Thomas Burton, all my undivided half interest in and to
 all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville
 Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

on the Paris Mountain Road near its confluence with the Rutherford Road, near the City of
 Greenville, bounded by lands of Barney Jackson, W.H. Ernhart, and the Paris Mountain Road,
 containing ninety-five one hundredths of an acre. Said lot is more fully described on plat
 made by Jas. K. Dickson, D.S. November 20th, 1889, being the same lot conveyed to my father
