(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged); have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Mrs. Laura R. Williams a certain piece or parcel of land lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, adjoining lands of Benjamin Barbary, George N. Stewart and myself: Beginning on a stone on a branch; thence S. 33 W. up the branch with B. Barbary line about seventy rods to Wo. down to a stone; thence 67 W. forty and a half rods with B.
