

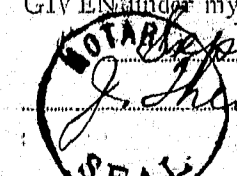
D. B. Traylor DEED TO J. B. Reeves

acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. B. Reeves, all that certain lot of land, situated in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and being a portion of Boyce's addition of Greenville, and having the following meter and bounds according to a plat thereof recorded in the Office of R. M. C. for County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in plat Book "C" at page 383, to wit:  
 Beginning at an iron pin on south side of Pettigrew St. corner of lot No. 9, plat J. S. R. N. Ward (the receipt whereof is hereby

acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said R. N. Ward, all that piece parcel and lot of land situated on the East side of Rowley Street, in the City of Greenville, known as lot #190w plat made by J. E. Sirring, recorded in R. M.
