Griffin, his heirs and assigns forever; All that certain piece or parcels of land, situate, lying and being in Ward one, of the City and County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, on Buncombe Street, and having the following maps and bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on Buncombe Street at the corner of lot heretofore conveyed by me to A. T.  KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That L. G. Lusk of the City and County of Greenville in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Five hundred and fifty Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by W. F. Heath (the receipt whereof is hereby

acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W. F. Heath all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, being a sub-division of the property of the Mount Airy Traction and Street Car Company, as per plat made by W. A. Adams, Esq., 1910 which plat is recorded in P.M.C. office for said County and State, being lot #35 of the said sub-division with 50 feet on Gridley Street extending 75 feet to an alley, thence 50 feet up on said alley, and thence 17.5 feet to the beginning corner, on Gridley Street. This deed is subject to the following conditions and restrictions, which are hereby declared to be conditions subsequent with the right of the grantor to re-enter upon either or any of the said conditions being violated: First: That the property is not to be sold, rented, or otherwise disposed of to persons of African descent. Second: That no liquor or ardent spirits are to be sold on the property. Third: That no house shall be built on the lot herein described to cost less than one thousand dollars, but any person may erect two or more lots, placing one residence thereon. Fourth: That no building shall be erected nearer the street than the building line shown on said plat, which is ten feet from the street. Fifth: That no use shall be made of the lots sold or any part thereof which would constitute a nuisance or injure the value of the neighboring lots. Sixth: That the layout of the lots as shown on said plat shall be adhered to, and no scheme for facing lots in any other direction than that shown on said plat shall be permitted. Seventh: That the company reserves the right to lay or place or authorize the laying and placing of electric or other street car tracks, sewer, gas and water pipes, electric conduits or pipes, telephone or electric light poles, or any other work or instruments of public utility, or in any of the streets or alleys adjacent to or crossing the said lot, without compensation to the purchaser or the owner of the said lot, the title of the lot shall revert to the grantor as against lien creditors and in the event of the violation of any of the other provisions above the grantor shall have the right to enforce the same in the same manner as provided in the proceedings above.
