hundred and eighty-four exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common
Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Mary J. Harris, Mary L. Harris and others

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the
21st, day of July 1884, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a ~~decree~~ ^{decretal order} of the said Court,
whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be sold by S.J. Douthit, Master in and for the County aforesaid, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said ~~decree~~ ^{decretal order}
as by reference thereto on file in said Court will appear; and the Master, after having duly advertised the said real estate for sale by public outcry on the
3rd, day of November in the year of our Lord ~~nineteen~~ ^{eighteen} hundred and eighty-four did then openly
and publicly, according to the custom of auction, sell and dispose of the same unto Mary J. Harris

being at that price the highest bidder therefor.
NOW, THEREFORE, Know all men by these Presents, that I, S.J. Douthit
Master in and for County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred
Dollars,
to me paid by the said Mary J. Harris

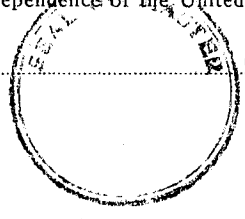
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release
unto the said Mary J. Harris, all that lot or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the

City and County of Greenville and State aforesaid, on the South side of Pendleton Street and
bounded by lots of F. Hahn on the East, on the South and West by lots of L. Williams:
Beginning at a stake on Pendleton Street, Hahn's corner and running; thence with said Street
a direct line towards the store house of L. Williams 32 feet to a stake 3X; thence S. 19-1/2
E. 106 feet in a line parallel with said store to a stake 3X; thence N. 70-1/2 E. 24-1/2 feet
to a stake 3X, Hahn's line; thence N. 19 W. 66-1/2 feet with said line to a stake 3X, corner
of Hahn's store; thence N. 11-1/4 W. 40 feet to the beginning corner, containing seven one-
hundredths of an acre, more or less. Being the lot deeded to W.C. Harris by L. Williams on the
4th, day of April 1877, said deed being recorded in R.M.C. Office, Book I.I., page 279.
