I, J.W. Gray, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:
WHEREAS, Angelene E. Walker by her guardian ad litem, Wilson C. Walker

on or about the 18th day of December in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and twelve exhibited her complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against L.A. Whitmire and Mrs. A.M. Caldwell

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 22nd day of December 1913, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be sold by J.W. NOW, THEREFORE, Know all men by these Presents, that I, J.W. Gray Master in and for County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Three thousand and five hundred Dollars, to me paid by the said L.A. Whitmire

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said L.A. Whitmire, All that lot and parcel of land situate in the State and

County aforesaid and the City of Greenville at the corner and Elkin and Nona Streets, and beginning at the corner of said Streets and running thence with Elkins Street ninety feet; thence S. 1-4 W. 165 feet to a stake on Harris' land; thence with said line N. 66 E. 143 feet to Nona Street; thence N. 27 W. 180 feet to the beginning corner.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever, of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and each of them in and to the same; and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or by these or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned, unto the said L.A. Whitmire, his

heirs and assigns forever.

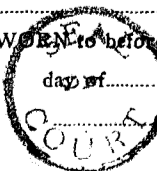
