Norwood, the following described real estate, to wit: all that piece, parcel and tract of lands situate in the State and County aforesaid on the White Horse Road, containing twelve acres, more or less, and beginning at a stake 3x0m on the white horse Road, and running thence with said Road N. 39 W. 10.15 to a stone on said Road; thence S. 15 - 1/2 W. 17.75 to a stone on Road; thence S. 65 E. 13.28 to the beginning corner, being known as tract #16 on plat recorded in the office of Register of Deeds Conveyance for said County, in Plat Book U, page 165, and bounded by lands of Mrs. Campbell Cooper, Mrs. Mabel Le Harles, Mrs. Esther Hughes and others, and being the same lot of land conveyed to the said Emma C. Butler by P. S. Butler by deed on March 21st, 1908 and recorded in said office in Book U. H. W., page 466.
