KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Sally C. Williman of Greenville
in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred (\$800.00) DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by
W.W. Williman (the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said
W.W. Williman, all that piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the
corporate limits of the City of Greenville, in Ward 5, and in the County and State aforesaid,
Beginning on an iron pin, on the South side of Dunbar Street, said pin being also in the
Northwest corner of lot No. 9, and running; thence along said Dunbar Street N. 76 W. fifty feet
to an iron pin on the edge of said Dunbar Street thence S. 18 W. two hundred and
fifteen feet to the line of a lot owned by one W.B. Holly; thence S. 76 E. fifty feet to an iron
pin, in the corner of lot No. 9; thence N. 18 E. two hundred and fifteen feet along the west line
of said lot No. 9, to the beginning point, or iron pin, on Dunbar Street. The lot contains ten
thousand seven hundred and fifty (10,750) square feet, more or less, and is the same parcel
of land that was to me sold and conveyed by W.H. Irvine by general warranty deed, bearing date
April 29, 1907, and which deed has been or will be duly recorded in the office of the Register
of Mesne Conveyance for the County and State aforesaid in Book 45 at page 254
along with this instrument.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise
incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said
W.W. Williman, and to his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and
forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said W.W. Williman, and to his

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against
every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
