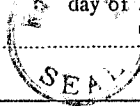


Frank Distler DEED TO S.D. Kennamore

Kennamore (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said S.D. Kennamore, all that piece, parcel & lot of land situated and being in the State and County aforesaid, with the following metes and bounds: Starting from an iron pin at E.N. Coles lot and Woodside Street; thence South fifty feet to pin; thence East one hundred feet to pin on land of Mrs. R.C. Honour; thence North fifty feet thence West one hundred to starting point, being part of lots No. 1 and 2 of a sub-division known as the Williman land and made by J.R. Easley, D.S. April 16, 1901 and conveyed to Frank Distler by W.W. Putnam May 23rd, 1906 and by W.J. Thackston July 18, 1903. Recorded in Vol. S.S.S. page 353 May 30, 1906, Vol. J.J.J. page 662, July 20, 1903.

 KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, Wade H. Moody and Ella Moody of Greenville County and in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Twenty-three hundred and twenty-five and no/100 DOLLARS, to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by M.O. Dunbar (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said M.O. Dunbar, All that piece, parcel and tract of land containing thirty-eight and one-half (38-1/2) acres, more or less, situate, lying and being in the western part of Greenville Township in the County and State aforesaid on Saluda River and Waters thereof, and Easley Bridge Road and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a branch, branch enter into Saluda River and running; thence up said branch as a line to a white-oak-stump 3X on the road leading to the City of Greenville; thence with said road to a pine 3X; thence N. 48 E. 20 chains to a stone 3X; thence N. 70 W. 14.50 chains to an Ash-stump 3X0; thence N. 21 E. 4.50 chains to a stake 3X0; thence N. 70 W. 7.40 chains to a stake 3X0 on Saluda River and thence with the meanders of the River to beginning corner, being the same tract of land conveyed to N. Corrie Cochran by John H. Pursley by deed bearing date the 30th, day of November 1898 and which was conveyed to the said Pursley by Priestly Maxwell on the 3rd, day of March 1897 and conveyed by deed to Wade H.
