 Barney Harris (the receipt whereof  
 is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said  
 Barney Harris, all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the  
 State of South Carolina and County of Greenville in the First Ward of the City of Greenville,  
 known and designated as the North portion of the east half of lot numbered eight (8) on map  
 numbered five (5) on a plat of the Stone Lands, made by J.N. Southern, bearing date the 14th, day  
 of September A.D. 1888, and filed in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyances for said  
 State and County, in Book "V.V" of deeds, at page 543; the lot of land hereby conveyed having the
