KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, J. J. Goldsmith and Wm. Goldsmith,
 both of the City and County of Greenville,

in the State aforesaid
 in consideration of the sum of
 Two Thousand DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid
 at and before the sealing of these presents by S. A. Curry, of Simpsonville, Greenville
 County, S. C.,

(the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

S. A. Curry, his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel
 or lot of land, situate, lying and being in Austin Township, State and
 County aforesaid, and within the Town of Simpsonville on East side
 of Railroad or Main Street and having the following metes and
 bounds, to-wit:-

Beginning at an iron pin on Main Street and running thence
 N. $77\frac{3}{4}$ E. $17\frac{3}{4}$ feet to an iron pin; thence N. $12\frac{1}{4}$ W. 40 feet to an
 iron pin; thence S. $77\frac{3}{4}$ W. $17\frac{3}{4}$ feet to an iron pin on Main
 Street; thence S. $12\frac{1}{4}$ E. 40 feet to the beginning corner, bounded
 by lands of W. P. Gresham, B. W. Burdett, the said J. and Wm.
 Goldsmith and said Main Street.

Also all that other certain piece, parcel or lot of land,
 situate, lying and being in Austin Township, said County and
 State, and in the Town of Simpsonville on East side of Railroad
 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:- Beginning
 on a corner of above described lot and running thence 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet
 to B. W. Burdett's line; thence with said Burdett's line 65 feet
 to J. H. Sullivan's corner; thence with J. H. Sullivan's line 17 $\frac{1}{2}$
 feet to side walk on said Main Street; thence along side
 walk 65 feet to the beginning corner - bounded by the above
 described lot on the North, on the South by lot of J. H. Sullivan,
 on the East by lot of B. W. Burdett, and on the West by the
 said Main Street, and being the same property conveyed to J. J.
 Goldsmith and A. S. Agnew by H. J. Haynesworth by deed dated
 the 12th day of Feb. 1912 and deed recorded in the office of the
 R. M. C. for Greenville County in Vol. 17 at page 420. The said A. S.
 Agnew having conveyed his interest to the said Wm. Goldsmith by
 deed dated the 23rd day of March 1912 and deed recorded in the
 office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Vol. 19 at page 58.

The warranty hereinafter set forth does not include any of
 that part of the within described lands that lies within the right
 of way of the Railway Company.

The said S. A. Curry agrees to assume the payment of note
 and mortgage of \$1000.00 over the above described property which
 was executed to J. M. Andrea by J. J. Goldsmith and A. S. Agnew
 on the 10th day of February 1912 and recorded in the office
 of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Vol. 22 at page 21. It
 being understood that the said J. J. and Wm. Goldsmith are to
 pay the interest on said mortgage to February the 12, 1914, the
 said S. A. Curry assuming it thereafter,
