James T. West, his heirs and assigns, all those two certain pieces, parcels or tracts of land described as follows, to wit:—First:—All that certain piece parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the state and County aforesaid and in Oaklawn Township, about Thirteen miles from Greenville Court House and on the Augusta Road, having the following notes and bounds, to wit:—Beginning at a point in Augusta Road on an old line between properties of James T. West and R. J. Hard, and running thence S. 76.50 E. 2139 feet to a stone, corner of other property of James T. West, thence S. 15.20 W. 818 feet to a stake; thence along line of other property of James T. West N. 88 W. 791 feet to a small Black Jack tree; thence S. 80.50 W. 2998 feet crossing Augusta Road to a stake; thence N. 15.20 E. 1273 feet to a stake; thence N. 77.10 E. 1653 feet to a point in Augusta Road; thence along Augusta Road N. 26.15 W. 140.5 to the point of beginning and containing ninety-six and one-half acres, more or less.
