DEED TO James T. West

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That A. P. Morris of the City of Atlanta,
in the County and

in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of
Ten and no dollars and other valuable considerations DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by James T. West of the City of Greenville,
State of South Carolina

(the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

James T. West, his heirs and assigns, all my rights, title and interest in those two certain tracts of land described as follows:—First, all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina and in Grove Township, And having the following metes and bounds to-wit:—Beginning at a point on Augusta Road 20 feet from a Red Oak Tree, on an old line and running thence with old line S. 77-10 W. 1653 feet to a stake, corner of other property of James T. West; thence along line of said property S. 15-20 W. 1273 feet to a stake on old line between properties of James T. West; thence with old line S. 80-50 W. 580 feet to Post Oak Tree; thence along line of other property of James T. West N. 57-10 W. 953 feet to a stone; thence along property of James T. West and the Hogan property N. 15-15 E. 2006 feet to a stone; thence along property of James T. West and R. D. McDavid property S. 76-50 E. 2804 feet to a point in center of Augusta Road; thence along said Augusta Road S. 26-15 E. 140.5 feet to the point of beginning. Same containing Eighty-Eight (88) acres, more or less, as per survey made by R. C. Dalton, March 1914, And being the same tract of land conveyed to me A. P. Morris by deed on Conveyance from Carrie Howard bearing date of February 11th, 1895 and recorded in office of Register of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County, S.C. in Deed Book "B.B.B." at page 178.

Said deed describes this tract as containing 92 acres, more or less, but survey shows that it contains 88 acres, more or less.

Second: All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being, in Grove Township, County of Greenville and in the State of South Carolina, about 13 miles from Greenville Court House on the Augusta Road and having the following metes and bounds to-wit:—Beginning at a stone X 30m and running thence S. 77-1/4 E. 36.70 to an Iron stake X 6; thence N. 14-1/2 E. 14.85 to an Iron stake X 3; thence N. 77-1/4 W. 36.70 to a Pine Knot X 3m; thence S. 14-1/2 W. 14.85 to the beginning corner and containing Fifty-Four and 1/2 (54.5) acres, more or less. This tract being known as a part of the Nesbit and Howbridge land. And being the same tract of land conveyed to me A. P. Morris by deed of conveyance from J. A. Morris bearing date of November 29th, 1905 and recorded in the office of Register of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Deed Book Vol. F.R.R. at page 136.

Prior conveyances, C. W. Nesbit and S. F. Howbridge to J. A. Morris by deed bearing date Nov. 8th, 1905 and recorded in said office in Deed Book R.R.R. at page 139.
