in consideration of the sum of  
Ten dollars and other valuable considerations DOLLARS,  
to me in hand paid  
at and before the sealing of these presents by

(the receipt whereof  
is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Sallie Hart Harris, one that certain lot or parcel of land, together with all  
and singular the building and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on  
Elkins Street, in the city of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, bounded and  
described as follows, to wit, Beginning at 9 P. 3 X, the 3 X of N. P. Whithere lot  
and running thence with said lot S 8° - 30' E. 221.5' to an I. P. in rear  
line; thence N. 66° 15' E. 106' to an I. P. 3 X; thence N. 0° - 30' W. 63'  
to an I. P. 3 X on North side of Elkins street; thence with Elkins street, N.  
80° - 45' W. 100' to the beginning 3 X - same being a portion of the real  
estate whereof the late Mrs. Fannie E. Harris died, Deeded and Transferred
