

The Norwood National Bank DEED TO J.H.Bagwell

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

The Norwood National Bank

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of United States and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty-Six Hundred and Forty-seven and 50/100 DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

J.H.Bagwell, his heirs and assigns forever, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate lying and being in Ward V. of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, at the corner of Anderson and St. John Streets and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at Stake, corner of Anderson and St. John Sts.; thence Southeasterly along St. John Street, 220 feet to an iron pin; thence northeasterly along line formerly owned by B.M. McGee, about 103 feet to iron pin; thence Northwesterly along B.M. McGees line about 209 feet to stake on Anderson Street thence Southeasterly along Anderson Street, 120 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same lot of land conveyed to Norwood National Bank by W.P. Stewart by deed dated Dec., 4th. 1909, and recorded in R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Volume 5, page 221. 211.

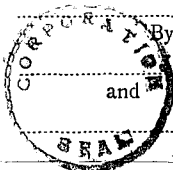
TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee... hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person who shall or lawfully claiming or to claim the same, on any point in this deed.

In witness whereof the said granting corporation has caused its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed and these presents to be subscribed by its duly authorized officers, J.W. Norwood, President and S.A. Moore, Cashier on this the 25th day of July, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and ten, and in the one hundred and thirty-fifth year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
