KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Paris Mountain Land Company, by R.D. Sloan, President and A.G. Furman, Treasurer a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

Jos. A. McCullough, all that piece, parcel or lot of land, in the State and County aforesaid, on the N.E. slope of Paris Mountain, containing thirty (30) acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

As per survey of F.G. Rogers, D.S. Beginning at a sower-wood corner; thence N. 50 W. 26 chains to an old fence corner on the original Thompson Land; thence N. 82.40 chains to a chestnut; thence S. 26 E. 14.80 chains to a chestnut stump; thence 3/4 E. 18 chains to the beginning corner; bounded by the lands of Markley, Wilson, Bolling and others.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

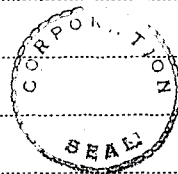
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns forever.
