in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Dollars, to me and other valuable consideration paid by W. E. Howard

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said W. E. Howard all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

near the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, in the village known as East Summit View on the north side of Fourth Street: Beginning at an iron pin at the eastern boundary line of lots heretofore conveyed by S. C. Stover to J. P. Stover and shown on plat made by F. G. Rogers, March 20th, 1910; thence with said Fourth Street in southeasterly direction 60 feet to an iron pin; thence in a northerly direction about one hundred fifty feet to the back line of lot No. 1 as shown on said plat; thence with the back line of lots Nos. 10 and 11 in a southwesterly direction seventy feet to corner of lot No. 1; thence with the line of lot No. 1 in a southerly direction one hundred forty feet to the beginning corner.
