KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Eva M. Putman of State and County and State aforesaid

in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Two thousand and no/100 DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

W.H. Henderson of same County and State (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

W.H. Henderson, all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land, lying and being situate in the County and State aforesaid, containing forty two acres, more or less, being the same conveyed to me by J.W. Gray, Master by a deed bearing date Oct. 14, 1905 and recorded in the office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in book K.K.K. at page 150, all of said lands described in deed made me by J.W. Gray, Master, conveying forty eight acres, more or less, except six acres previous to this to W.S. Peden.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said W.H. Henderson, and his heirs and assigns forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself & my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said W.H. Henderson, and his

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
