to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by S.R. Roe, of the State and County aforesaid (the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

S.R. Roe, and his heirs and assigns forever, all that certain tract of land known as Lot number Six in the division of the Real Estate of H.D.
