KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. F. White, Trustee of the Bankrupt estate of J. D. Sheppard, of the County and State aforesaid in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of One and no/100 DOLLARS,

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. D. Sheppard, and on account of the Homestead exemption (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted; Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

J. D. Sheppard, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on North Street and Richland Creek in Ward two of the City of Greenville in County and State aforesaid and having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at an iron pipe on North Street, corner of Mr. Sheppard's property, thence with line of North Street N. 69.37 E. 62 ft. to a point in large rock; thence with line of W.C. Cleveland's property S. 37.15 E. 115 ft. to a stake near bank of Richland Creek; thence down meanders of Richland Creek as follows: S. 49.32 W. 69.5 ft. to a stake; thence S. 9.47 W. 51.1 ft. to a stake; thence S. 57.14 W. 82.5 ft. to a stake; thence S. 20-14 W. 43.0 ft. to a stake; thence S. 83.38 W. 53.4 ft. to a stake, corner of lots Nos. 135 and 136 in sub-division known as East Park; thence with line of Lot 135 N. 15.22 E. 266.0 ft. to the point of beginning.
