to me, in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by H. J. Gilreath, Greenville County,
S. C.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargain, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said H. J. Gilreath his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville State of South Carolina, Township and Range the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stone at the N.E. corner of Lot 18, J. H. Gilreath's corner, and running thence N. 58° 38.80' chain to a tree, thence S. 76 1/2° E. 13.65' chain to stone, thence N. 19 3/8° E. 2.50' chain to stone division corner, thence N. 19 3/8° W. 44.75' chain along the land that I conveyed to W. A. Price, to iron pine on the McElhany Fork Road, thence with said road S. 83 3/4° W. 4.28' to the beginning corner, containing forty (40) acres more or less, according to survey of W. L. Adams, May 21st 1913, this being part of a larger tract which was settled to me by my said son, John H. Gilreath by my mother Jane G.
