KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That *L. M. Norwood* of the county of *Greenville* in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of *Five hundred & no/00* DOLLARS, to *me* in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by *Mary E. McCleath* (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargain, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Mary E. McCleath, her heirs and assigns all that certain lot or parcel of land situate but outside of the corporate limits of the City of Greenville County aforesaid known as lot number four(4) acre five(5) in plat of survey of land of *L. M. Norwood* known as Norwood, being made by *J. B. Trotter* surveyor, bearing date October 9th 1908 and recorded in office of Register of Surveyor of Greenville County in Plat Book 1 page 133. The lots said lots have a frontage of one hundred feet (100 ft) on Vance Street and a depth of one hundred and fifty feet (50) ft from Vance street to land of the Woodside Cotton Mill.

TOGETHER WITH, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said *Mary E. McCleath*, her heirs and assigns, forever.
