Mrs. Pearl Gaines (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargain, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Mr. Pearl Gaines her heirs and assigns forever all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate at the south side of David Street in Ward one of the City of Greenville County and State aforesaid and known as lot no. 12, on a plat of the same bought of C. R. Hamlet et al. and being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows: Beginning at an angle in the south line of David Street, and corner of N. Maywell property, thence with line of Maywell property, S. 58 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. one hundred and eighty five feet to a stake thence with line of lots no 1 and 2 N. 23 $\frac{3}{4}$  W. ninety two feet to stake corner with line of lots 2, 5, and 13, thence with the line of lot no. 13 N. 66 $\frac{1}{4}$  E. one hundred and eighty feet to a stake in line of David street, thence with David street S. 23 $\frac{3}{4}$  E. forty feet to the beginning corner, containing 30 feet acre, more or less (and being the same lot conveyed to me by Mountain Title and Improvement Company, dated bearing date 26th day of September 1910 and recorded in T.
