J.W. Andrea all that piece or lot of land situated, lying and being in said State and County of Oconee, South Carolina, on the Dugby Bridge Public road, containing lands, viz: - said W. J. Edwards and the said J.W. Andrea, having the following written and bounded viz: - Begining on a rock in the said road and running thence S. 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 73 $\frac{1}{2}$ chains to a stone, thence N. 34 W. 41 $\frac{1}{2}$ chains to a tree, thence S. 44 E. 8. 65 chain to the beginning corner, and containing three acres, more or less.
