A.H. Miller, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargain, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

A.H. Miller, all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and county aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stake in center of Enoree River and runs thence with said River's meanderings as a line to another stake in center of said river, W.O. on bank N.M.; thence S. 19 W. 2.70 chs. to poplar; thence S. 37 W. 2.66 chs. to birch; thence S. 74 W. 2.12 chs. to stake; thence S. 89 W. 1.75 chs. to sweet gum; thence S. 63-1/2 W. 2.90 chs. to pine; thence S. 87 W. 3.13 chs. to stone; thence S. 7 E. 1.50 chs.; thence S. 29 E. 4.80 chs.; thence N. 61 W. 6.50 chs.; thence N. 58 W. 21.40 chs. thence N. 24-1/2 E. 31.50 chs. to the beginning corner, containing eighty-two and one-half acres more or less, and is known as Lot No. 4 on Ferguson's survey of lands of W.B.
