KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That W.J. Gibson, of County of Spartanburg

in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred (\$700.00) DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

J.B. Prewett (the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargain, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

J.B. Prewett All that certain lot or parcel of land situated, lying and being in State and
County aforesaid, on west side of road leading from Gowensville by S.G. and J.O. Wingos' in
direction of Greers, adjoining lands of S.G. Wingo, P. Turner, Edward Skinner and Robert-
McMillan. Beginning at iron pin in S.G. Wingos line on east side of road thence N. 48.38 W.
18.00 to stone corner of S.G. Wingo and P. Turner, thence N. 35-1/4 E. 11.45 to stone, thence
N. 87 E. 3.40 to W.O. stump, thence N. 20-3/4 E. 2.02 to stone, thence N. 75 E. 25.48 to
stone, thence S. 57.38 W. 19.21 to iron pin, thence S. 50 E. 3.28 with road, bend, thence S.
19 E. with road 1.63 bend, thence S. 35 W. 7.21 to beginning, containing 25-17/100 acres, more
or less, this tract and the tracts deeded to Robert McMillan and Edward Skinner compose the
same one hundred acres deeded to me by J.M. Jackson on July 2nd, 1910 said deed being
destroyed in the burning of my home before it was recorded, another deed was executed in lieu

J.B. Prewett, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and
forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said J.B. Prewett, his

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against
every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
