

Julius D. Green DEED TO J. B. Rasor

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Julius D. Green, of Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One thousand seven hundred and seventy one and 25/100 Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. B. Rasor, of the State and County aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargain, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

J. B. Rasor, his heirs and assigns, All of that certain piece parcel and tract of land, situate, lying and being in Greenville County, and State aforesaid in Butler Township, near Roper Mountain Baptist Church, adjoining lands of Warrum Green, J. D. Green and others, having the following metes and bounds:—Beginning at stone yard and apple tree and thence N 36 3/4 W. 13.15 to iron pin in road leading to Greenville S. C. thence following the said road a part of the way S. 51 1/4 W. 21.35 to iron joint in settlement road, thence with said road S. 43 3/8 E. 15.25 to stake in gully, thence N 47 7/8 E. 5.35 to stake, thence N. 20 E. 2.17 to stake thence N 6 1/4 W. 1.60 to stone 3 X 0 W. thence N. 45 1/4 E. 4.65 to Locust, thence N 61 E 7.25 to the beginning, containing twenty seven and 25/100 acres more or less, being the same tract of land conveyed to me by James D. Green, by deed, dated 14th day of November 1906, and recorded in Merne Conveyance Office in Vol. 511, p. 480.

TOGETHER WITH, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said J. B. Rasor, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said J. B. Rasor, his heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
