This Association for itself, and successors and assigns, covenants that the lot or lots herein referred to and which is a part hereof, shall receive annual care hereafter of lawns, flowers, shrubs, trees and all headstones, curbing and other stone work kept plumb, straight or in proper condition, except such work as referred to in rule 9, the aim being to keep the lots in perpetuity for all time to come. The Association is not responsible for the wear or damage to monuments by the elements, and will not repair or replace them.
- 11. No coping or other means of marking boundaries of lots or graves can be used except corner stones herein provided.
