Monuments or portions of vaults, above ground, shall not be of material other than cut stone, granite, marble, or cement, but with the consent of the Superintendent other material may be used in erecting monuments, and vaults. Work must be completed as fast as possible under the inspection of the Superintendent, and material not used must be removed as the mork is completed. All foundations are built by the Association at the market price. All head and foot stones must have at least two inches thickness for every foot in height; those one foot in height must be two inches thick; two feet in height or less must be four inches thick, etc. No material of any kind will be received at the Cemetery on Saturday after twelve, noon. When monuments, headstones, etc., are placed upon any lot sold, no removal of same will be permitted to be made under claim that they are not paid for or other pretense without authority of the Association.
