- 5. No disinterment shall be allowed without permission of the Superintendent.

6. The Association, from time to time, may lay out or alter such avenues or walks, or make such rules and regulations for the government of the Cemetery grounds as they may deem requisite or proper to promote the general objects of the Cemetery. 7. The prices of lots include all charges for grading and care in accordance with the rules and regulations laid down by the Association and as re-

8. All sales of lots are made strictly for cash, unless in special cases an extension is given by the Association.
