

A. Fuller DEED TO J.A. Brockman THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, COUNTY OF Greenville

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, A. Fuller in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Three thousand no/100 DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J.A. Brockman (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said J.A. Brockman, his heirs and assigns, All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land... situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville, in Centt Township, on the Augusta Road and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning on a persimmon tree (now down) on the Augusta Road and running thence S. 41 E. 16.40 to a stone 3XOM; thence S. 53 E. 8.00 to a stone 3XOM; thence N. 52 1/2 E. 7.20 to a stone 3XOM; thence N. 52 W. 7.50 to a stone in a stump 3XOM; thence N. 50 E. 6.86 to a stone 3XOM; thence N. 20 W. 19.55 to a stone 3XOM in the Augusta Road; thence along said road as the line 32.00 to the beginning corner, and containing 35 1/2 acres, more or less; this being the same tract of land conveyed to me by A.F. Spruill by deed dated 4th, day of November 1916 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for said State and County in Vol. #41, at page 333, to which reference is hereby made.

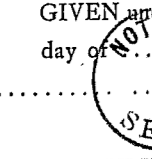

Milford, his heirs and assigns forever, All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the City and County of Greenville, State aforesaid on Grove Street, designated as lots Nos. 7 and 20 on a plat of the land purchased by H.H. Harris from B.E. Geer and S.A. Moore made by W.A. Hudson, March 21st, 1908 and registered in the office of the Register of Meane Conveyance for Greenville County in plat book "A", page 225.
