Harris, his heirs and assigns, all of our respective undivided rights, title and interest, being a one-eighths each, of, in and to all the lots and parcels of land herein- after described, having the courges, dimensions and location as is shown on the plat recorded ar to be recorded, along with this deed, to wit:-

First: Augusta Street property: plat of same recorded in Plat Book C, at page 261; lots Nos. 15, 4, 22, 30, 13.

Second: West Highland property; plat of same recorded in Plat book C, at pages 258-259 lots Nos. M.

Third: East Highland property: plat of same recorded in Plat Book C, at page 146; lots Nos. 50, 71, 59, 61, 64, 67.
