 by acknowledged), have granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

W. I. Storey, all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid and in the Township of Saluda flow Caneys Creek branch waters of Much Creek and South Tigger Creek and runs as follows: Beginning at a stone corner on the public road which leads from the State road to the Banyone road at Linna and is a corner of the lands of J. Henry Trammell, J. B. Carr and W. I. Storey and runs thence with Storey line to a stone corner on Solly line, thence with Solly line a southwest direction to a stone corner, thence N. E. with Storey line to a stone corner, thence N. E. to an iron pin in Creek; thence with the meander of said Creek and said Storey line to a stone on the said Henry Trammell line, thence in an easterly direction and with said Trammell line to a stone corner on said public road; thence in a Northerly direction with Trammell line to the beginning corner, containing sixty seven acres, more or less.
