by acknowledged), have granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

W. H. Storer, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, being and lying in Greenville Township, State and County aforesaid, in the City of Greenville, on the East side of Tannoy Street and described as follows:
Beginning, at a stake on the East side of Tannoy Street, 201.3 feet from Cleveland's pipe and running thence N. 20-19-5. fifty-six feet with Cassinoff street to a stake, thence S-71-30-6.
