Elizabeth Farrand J.I. Shockley, all that certain tract of land, situate in Paris Mountain Town-  
ship, County and State aforesaid, being a part of the real estate of Pleasant Shockley, deceased  
and being all of a tract of land containing fifty five (55) acres, more or less, conveyed to me
