Mitchell's land; thence S. 87 1/2 E. 2 3/13 to a stone corner of Wm. Mitchell's land and lot No. 1 of J. D. Hill's estate; thence N. 9 W. 17.60 to a stone adjoining lots No. 1 and 2 of said J. D.
