WHEREAS, Ida B. Green, et al

on or about the 10th day of December in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirteen exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 20th day of February 1913, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. J. Inman Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Ida B. Green

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No.         )  
NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. J. Inman Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$248.00 HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

A.A. Green, All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and containing fifty-two and 60/100 (52.60) acres, and being known and designated as tract No. two according to a plat of Abraham Green's estate, made by Will D. Neves, Eng. on October 22nd, 1913, and having the following metes and bounds, and courses and distances, to-wit:  
Beginning at an iron pin in road, common corner of tract No. 1 and No. 2, and running thence South 8.15 East 39.25 to stake nm in the Brushy Creek line; thence along said creek line 3.70 to a point xm; thence along said creek line 5.90 to a point xm; thence along said creek line 7.00 to a point 3x; thence along said creek line 6.60 to a point xm; thence along said creek line 3.60 to a willow stump in middle of creek; thence North 30.35 West 41.75 to an iron pin in road; thence along said road south 81 West 7.46 to an iron pin at the beginning corner, this being tract No. 2 in a subdivision of the tract of land which was set apart to Jane E. Green in the division of the Abraham Green Estate, and being bounded by lands of Larkin Stuart Mrs. Lena Miller, A.A. Green, and tracts No. 1 and No. 3 in the sub-division of the Jane E. Green tract of land above referred to.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever, of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same; and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Ida B. Green, et al heirs and assigns forever.
