Maggie M. Babb, and Annie M. League

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto

F. C. Thomason, Marie A. Brooks, Gertrude A. Brooks, Maggie M. Babb,
and Annie M. League, the following described real estate:
"All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situate, lying
and being in Fairview Township, County and State aforesaid,
on the north side of Reedy River and being a part of the land
conveyed by Giornach P. Pedee to David T. Pedee by Deed which is
recorded in the R. M. C. Office for the County and State aforesaid
in Deed Book V page 224, and being known and designated as
Tracts No. 2 and 3 according to a plat and sub-division of the lands
above referred to made by J. B. Adams, Surveyor, on the 2nd day of
September 1912, and more particularly described as follows:

said tract and running thence S. 7 E. 5.20 to a stone 3X; thence
S. 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ W. 23.00 to a stone 3X; thence S. 14 W. 23.13 to a stone
