to me paid by the said J. J. McSwain

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by the ~~the~~ Present DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said

J. J. McSwain, the following described real estate, to wit:
"all that certain piece, parcel, and tract of land, situate,
lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as Tracts Nos. 7 and 8
according to a subdivision and plat of the lands of J. C. Allen,
deceased, made by B. F. Moore, Surveyor, on July 15 the third day of Aug. 16th
1915 and more particularly described as follows: - Tract No. 7
contains eleven and one-half ($1\frac{1}{2}$) acres, and has the following
metes and bounds and corners and distances, to-wit: Be-
ginning at a stone and running thence N. $1\frac{1}{2}$ E. 4.50 to a stake;
thence N. $58\frac{1}{2}$ E. 3.94 to stone; thence N. $25\frac{1}{2}$ W. 23.00 to a corner;
thence S. 1 W. 16.90 to stone; thence S. $33\frac{1}{2}$ E. 12.94 to the beginning
corner."

a stone; thence S. $43\frac{1}{2}$ E. 8.00 to a stone near large pine; thence S. $33\frac{1}{2}$ E. 28.40 to a stake on branch line; thence along the
meandering of said branch line to the beginning
corner."
