WHEREAS, on May 20, 1915, W. H. Irvine, of the County and State aforesaid, did file his petition in bankruptcy in the United States District Court for Western District of South Carolina, praying that he be adjudged a bankrupt; and _____

WHEREAS, said Court did, upon due consideration, on the same day adjudge the said W. H. Irvine a bankrupt; and _____

WHEREAS, at a meeting of the creditors of the said W. H. Irvine subsequently held on June 2, 1915, H. P. McGEE, W. P. CONYERS and W. T. HENDERSON were duly elected and qualified as Trustees of said estate and are now engaged in the performance of their duties as Trustees; and _____

WHEREAS, by certain orders, to-wit:- An order in the said Court in the above case, bearing date October 14, 1915, and order of J. J. McSwain, Referee in Bankruptcy, bearing date November 5th, 1915, said Trustees were authorized to sell the tract of land hereinafter mentioned at the price hereinafter stated, free from dower claim and from all liens and encumbrances:

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of said orders, we H. P. McGEE, W. P. CONYERS and W. T. HENDERSON as Trustees of said estate, in consideration of the sum of Thirteen Hundred and Ninety Dollars,

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by H. C. & Gertrie Lee Stewart (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and, by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said H. C and Gertrie Lee Stewart, all that certain piece parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid and just beyond the corporate limits of the City, near the Cuttlerford Road, and East of said road and fronting on a street or lane, extending into said road containing One and 05/100 acres, more or less, and adjoining lands now or formerly owned by Mrs. Eliza Brisco, City Barberian, Maria Rodgers and others, said lot may be more accurately described by metes and bounds, courses and distances, as follows: Beginning at a stake 3 X 0 m., on said street or lane, and running thence N. 22 3/4 E. 3.24 to a stone 3 X 0 m.; thence N. 67 1/4 W. 3 1/8 to an iron pin; thence S. 26 1/2 W. 3 1/6 to an iron pin in said street or lane; thence along said twelve foot street or lane S. 65 1/4 E. 3.40 to the beginning stake, as will more fully appear by reference to plat of said lot made by J. H. Southern, C. S. dated June 27th, 1900, and being the same lot of land conveyed to W. H. Irvine deceased by deed dated September 22nd, 1905, and recorded in the R. M.
