WHEREAS, on May 20, 1915, W. H. Irvine, of the County and State aforesaid, did file his petition in bankruptcy in the United States District Court for Western District of South Carolina, praying that he be adjudged a bankrupt; and

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Mark Joseph (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and, by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mark Joseph (All that certain piece parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Ward Five of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, on Wade Street, and having a frontage on said Wade Street of two hundred and ten (210) feet, with a depth of two hundred and ten (210) feet, and being the same lot conveyed to W. H. Irvine, bankrupt, deceased, by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. C. C. C., at Page 535.)

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said
