B. Corbin of Greenville County, in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Seventy (\$70.00) & no/100 DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the said V. L. Johnson and in consideration of the above recital

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said V. L. Johnson, and his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville, in Greve Township, on the Greenville-Piedmont dirt road, near Piedmont, S.C. and having the following metes and bounds, according to a survey and plat thereof made by R.R. Dalton, Surveyor dated Jany. 1st. 1910 of the Cleveland & Williams Sub-division; said plat is recorded in Plat Book "B", in the R.M.C. office for said County and State, to wit:
